


Slovak Presidency of the Council of the European Union



SOME STATISTICS

Bratislava

- informal summit;
- 20 ministerial meetings and conferences;
- 6 parliamentary events;
- 180 expert meetings;
- 26.000 delegates (833 VIP guests; more than 1500 journalists);
- 60 visits from EU institutions;
- social and cultural activities more than 450.000 participants

Brussels

- 53 ministerial meetings
- more than 1200 working groups meetings

Budget: planned 70 mil. EUR - spent: cca 55-56 mil. EUR

LOCAL ACTIVITIES (more then 30):

- EU HoMs meetings with Bulgarian representatives (Presidents, Ministers,...)
- Cultural events (exhibitions Sofia, Varna; concerts Sofia, Plovdiv; film festival)
- Social events (presentations; Blood Donation Day; discussions with students - Sofia, Veliko Tarnovo, Varna, Blagoevgrad)

MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

3 principles: Pragmatic + Uniting + People's voice

These principles are mutually reinforcing – we believe that with (1) tangible results that (2) help overcome the fragmentation, we can bring (3) real added value for our citizens.

Key event: Bratislava Summit (Sep 16, 2016)
(Bratislava Declaration, Bratislava Road Map, BG: 160 mil. EUR)

MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

 - ✓ EU budget for 2017
 - ✓ new elements of the EU Cohesion Policy
 - ✓ Directive on the fight against fraud to the EU's financial interests (PIF directive) and Proposal on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's office (EPPO regulation)

Digital Single Market

- ✓ Geo-blocking regulation to ban unjustified geo-blocking between MS
- ✓ Abolition of roaming charges by June 2017
- ✓ Boosting mobile internet for all



MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

- External Relations and Trade
 - ✓ signing of CETA EU-Canada trade agreement
 - ✓ ratification of the Paris Climate Agreement
 - ✓ enlargement policy 4 new chapters opened in the accession process with Serbia, 2 ch. with Montenegro
 - ✓ visa liberalisation with Georgia and Ukraine
