INSTRUCTIONS ON FILLING-IN THE GOODS CUSTOMS DECLARATION

I. General instructions

- On entering, travellers-persons established in the Republic of Bulgaria fill in ii. 1.1, 1.2, 3 and 4, while on leaving
 - ii. 1, 2.1 and 2.2 of the Goods Customs Declaration. When a traveller-person established in the Republic of
 Bulgaria does not carry goods subject to declaring under the above provisions, a Goods Customs Declaration
 shall not be filled in
- On entering, travellers-persons established outside the Republic of Bulgaria fill in i.1.2, i.2 and i.4, while on leaving — i.1 and i.3 of the Goods Customs Declaration. When a traveller - person established outside the Republic of Bulgaria does not carry goods subject to declaring under the above provisions, a Goods Customs Declaration shall not be filled in.
- When the traveller is under 16 years old, his/her personal data shall be filled in the Goods Customs Declaration and signed by one of his/her accompanying majors.
 - Both travellers persons established in or outside the Republic of Bulgaria, are obliged, on entering and leaving to declare in writing with a Single Administrative Document /SAD/ the following goods: goods of a commercial nature, goods subject to specific formalities of the corresponding customs procedure and goods for which refunds of customs duties or other payments might be claimed. Travellers persons established outside the Republic of Bulgaria are obliged to declare in writing with a Single Administrative Document the temporary import of personal belongings and goods for sports purposes for which the customs duties are high. On traveller's request it is also possible in all other cases to declare with a Single Administrative Document.

II. On entering

- In i.1.1 shall be filled in the goods of a non commercial nature acquired by the traveller abroad and imported personally by him when they exceed the below-stated duty-free limits. When on entering unaccompanied luggage is declared in i.4, all the goods acquired abroad and their total intrinsic value at the moment of their import shall be declared in 1.1. The Declaration shall be submitted by the traveller to the Customs Office for the purpose of customs clearance of the unaccompanied luggage.
- In i.1.2, the traveller shall fill in the goods of a non commercial nature, which on import are subject to prohibitions, restrictions and specific control.
- In i.2, the traveller shall fill in the goods of a non commercial nature, which on temporary importation are subject to prohibitions, restrictions and specific control¹.
- In i.3, the traveller shall fill in the reimported goods that had already been declared as temporary export with such a Goods Customs Declaration form.

III. On leaving

- In i.1 the goods of a non commercial nature which on export are subject to prohibitions, restrictions or specific control' shall be filled in.
- In i.2.1 the goods of a considerable value exported by the traveller which he/she intends to reimport into the Republic of Bulgaria shall be filled in.
- In 2.2. goods of a non commercial nature exported by the traveller which on temporary importation are subject to prohibitions, restrictions and specific control¹ shall be filled in by the traveller.
- In i.3, the traveller shall fill in the reexported goods which had already been declared for temporary importation in i.2 on entering the country.

LIMITS OF DUTY FREE IMPORT

- Each traveller over 16 is entitled to import duty free:
- 1.1. 200 pieces of cigarettes, or 100 pieces of cigarillos, or 50 pieces of cigars, or 250 g of smoking tobacco (of one type or assortment proportionately to these different types of goods).
- 1.2. A total of 1 I distilled and spirituous beverages of 22% vol. or more, undenatured ethyl alcohol of 80% vol. or more.
- 1.3. A total of 2 l of distilled and spirituous beverages of 22% vol. or lower, sparkling or desert wines.
- 1.4. A total of 2 Lof still wines.
- 1.5. 500 g of coffee, or 200 g of coffee extract.
- 1.6. 100 g of tea, or 40 g of tea extract.
- 1.7. 50 g of perfume and 250 ml of toilet water.
- 1.8. Medicines, in quantities and type, corresponding to the traveller's personal needs
- 1.9. Goods, acquired abroad, different from those included in items 1.1 through 1.8, the total intrinsic value of which is up to USD 100 inclusive or its equivalent in another currency.
- Each traveller under 16 is entitled to import duty free:
- 2.1. Medicines, in quantities and type, corresponding to the traveller's personal needs.
- 2.2. Goods, acquired abroad, different from those included in items 1.1, through 1.7, the total intrinsic value of which is up to USD 50 inclusive or its equivalent in another currency.
- Persons, crossing the border more than once within 30 successive days are entitled to reduced limits of duty free import as follows:
- 3.1. Goods acquired abroad, the total intrinsic value of which is up to USD 20 or its equivalent in another currency
- 3.2. 20% of the duty free import limits, stated in items 1.1, through 1.7, and medicines, in quantities and type, corresponding to the traveller's personal needs.
