Preparation for the exhibition (set up of the booth) by each exhibitor

9:30 Start registration for Japanese buyers

10:00 Start the fair

11:30 – 14:00 Lunch buffet is available

16:30 Close the fair

16:30 – 17:30 Close the booths by each exhibitor

17:30 Close the conference room

Notes:

- ✓ Each exhibitor is requested to come to the conference room between 8:00 and 9:30 in the morning on 28th, and to display a booth by him/herself.
- ✓ How to display the booth is referred to "3. Setting booth"
- ✓ Japanese buyers come to the conference room after 9:30, and freely visit each booth
- ✓ Lunch is available between 11:30 and 14:00
- ✓ Every participants can take a lunch whenever he/she wants, and lunch is completely free of charge
- ✓ Smoking is prohibited in the conference room

We provide following facilities for each exhibitor and all of them are free of charge.

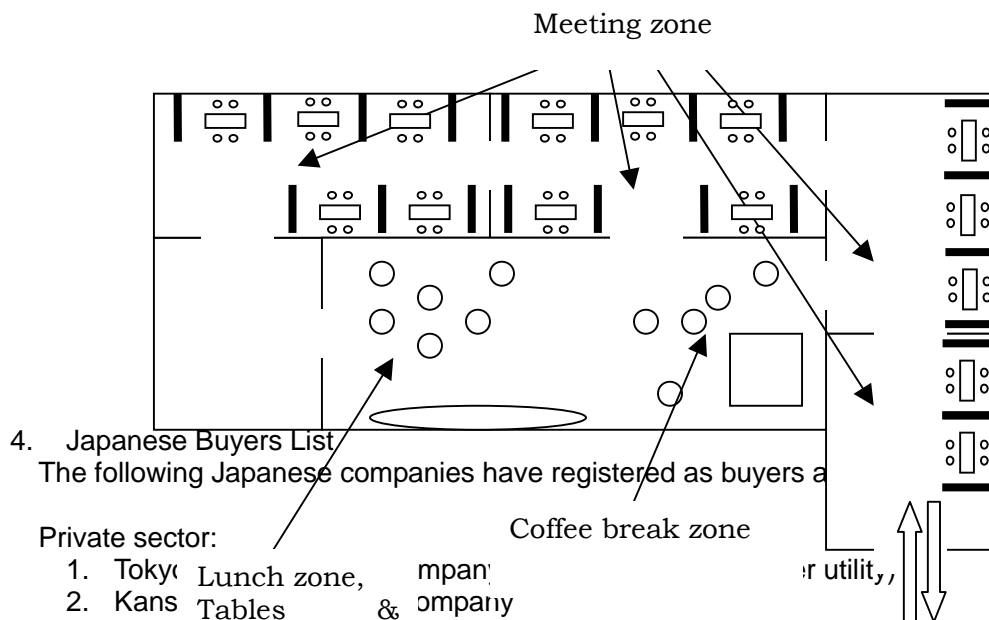
1. One long table (about 2m x 0.5m)
