The Kyrgyz Republic is an important transit country in Central Asia, as the most important trade routes pass through our territory. Historically, all three branches of the Silk Road pass through Kyrgyzstan.

PRIORITY SECTORS OF ECONOMY



There are 5 free economic zones in Kyrgyz Republic

FEZ "Bishkek"

Located in the capital of the country
- economic and political center

FEZ "Maimak"

Conveniently located at the intersection of routes of international transport corridors

FEZ "Leilek"

Favorable location for the development of cross-border trade

FEZ "Karakol"

Offers huge opportunities for tourism development

FEZ "Naryn"

Area is 47 thousand km² that is about 1/4 of all the territory of the country



Advantages of FEZ:

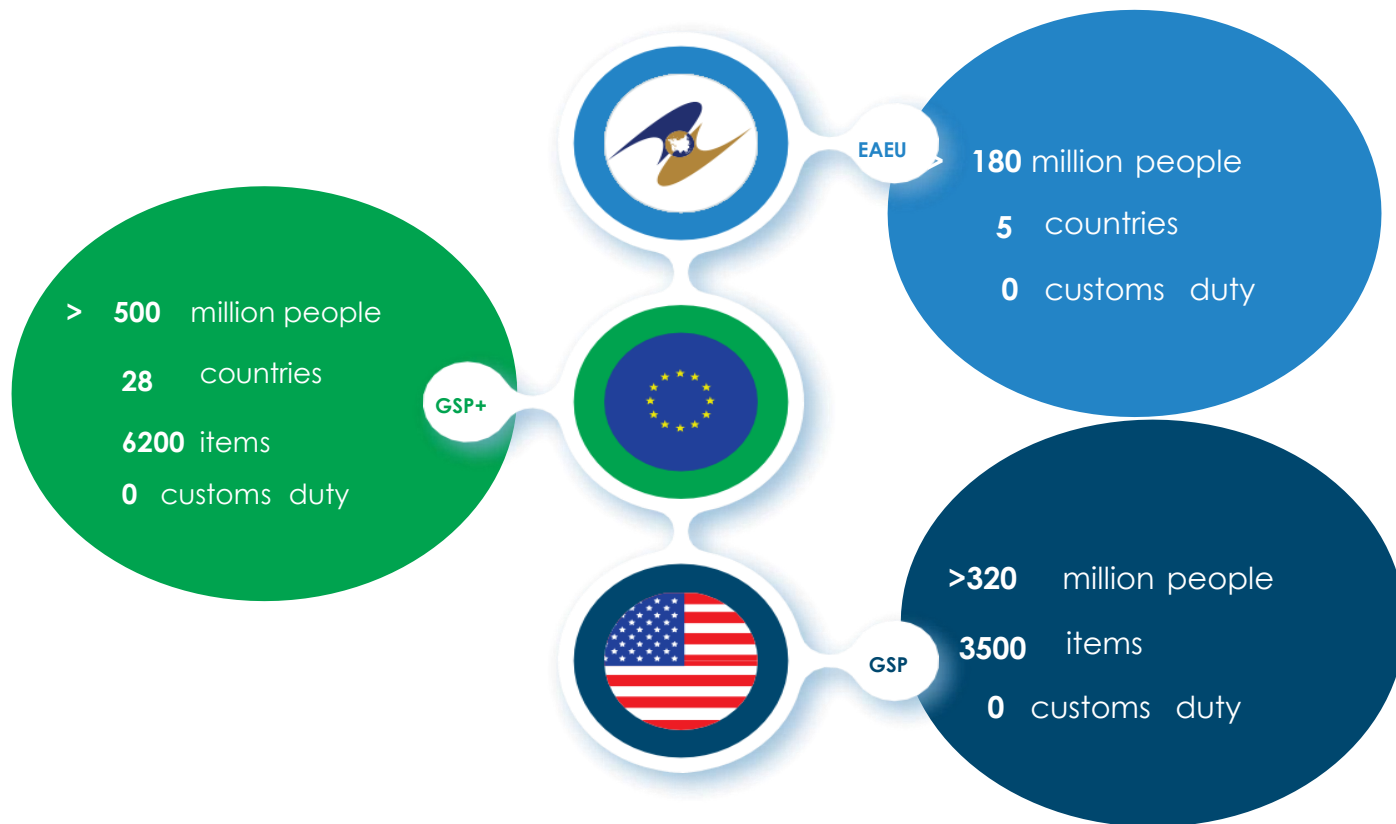
- Low cost of rental for land and properties
- Exemption from all taxes
- Exemption from customs duties
- Simplified customs clearance procedures
- Simplified and accelerated registration of legal entity

The Kyrgyz Republic is a member of the Eurasian Economic Union with the right to enter the market of 5 countries, without customs duties.

Since 2016, the Kyrgyz Republic has received the status of the GSP+ of the European Union, which allows duty-free importation of more than 6200 commodity items to the markets of the European Union.

Any foreign businessman in Kyrgyzstan will be able to use the above customs and trade benefits of Kyrgyzstan for exports to the countries of the Eurasian Economic Union, the European Union and USA.

The Kyrgyz Republic has created a fairly liberal tax regime for business entities and investors. When launching industrial, export-oriented and innovative enterprises in subsidized settlements of the republic, foreign investors are granted exemption from paying four types of taxes: sales tax, income tax, land tax and real estate tax, for a period of 5 years and with the possibility of extension up to 10 years.



The hydropower potential of the Kyrgyz Republic is 142 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity, of which the republic uses only 10%.

The Kyrgyz Republic is a participant in the largest energy project CASA-1000, which is designed to connect the energy systems of Central Asia with South Asia - Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan with Afghanistan and Pakistan and develop mechanisms for trading electricity in accordance with international standards.
