

I. ROLE OF AGRICULTURE IN VIET NAM'S ECONOMY Agrotrode Vietnam

- Agriculture took an important role in Viet Nam's economic development and support the political and social stability.
- Agriculture generates works and income for about 70% of Viet Nam's population; took 7.1% exported value and contributes about 12.36% GDP in 2021.


Proportion of main sectors in GDP 2021 (%)



Value of Agriculture Production in Viet Nam

- In 2021, the total value of agricultural production reached **34.71** Billion USD (12.36% GDP 2021)
- Agricultural export 2021: **48.6** Billion USD (core Agri-products: **21.49** Billion USD, Wood and wood products: **15,96** Billions USD, Fisheries: **8,89** Billion USD, Breeding: **434** Million USD)

Implement the Plan to restructure agricultural product processing towards improving processing capacity in association with market development until 2020; orientation to 2030



Fomulate and submit to the Prime Minister: (1) Strategy for the development of mechanization of agriculture and agro-forestry-fishery processing industry by 2030; (2) Project on developing the fruit and vegetable processing industry, wood and fishery products; (3) Strategy for the development of agricultural mechanization and agro-processing industry by 2030.



Many large corporations have focused on investing in logistics and processing agricultural products



Since 2017, 60 projects have been invested in the construction and processing of agricultural, forestry and fishery products with a total investment capital of 45,307 billion VND. In 2020, there are 12 key projects started and inaugurated with a total investment capital of 11,907 billion VND


