

Removing artificial restrictions on foreign trade and substantially reducing import tariffs for nearly 8,000 items



Introducing a visafree regime for the citizens of 76 countries as well as special visas for investors







Performance of Uzbekistan in various international rankings in 2016 and 2021










Population and its growth rate



FEZ locations across Uzbekistan (2022)












