1. Project Objectives

The project TRANSFER has two main specific objectives:

- 1. To transfer the best practices of social dialogue so far developed in the ATM sector to the other civil aviation sub- sectors, i.e. air crew and ground handling, and, simultaneously, trigger a country-based identification of the challenges and opportunities of improvement related to social dialogue applied to these sectors.
- 2. To facilitate a trans-national and EU-level exchange of experiences and practices between social partners of the civil aviation sector, with the aim to collect and elaborate recommendations for the European Sectorial Social Dialogue Committee dedicated to civil aviation.

2. Expected results

Through a consortium of trade unions and employers' organizations from Italy, Poland, Bulgaria, Romania and Montenegro, and with the support of CESI and ATCEUC as associated partners, the project will have a three-fold strategy:

- a. A capacity building focused on the ATM social dialogue's best practices, connected to an activity of country-based assessment of challenges related to social dialogue in air crew and ground handling sectors.
- b. The development of recommendations for the improvement of the EU-level and national social dialogue of civil aviation, based on a international consultation and leading to a Publication.
- c. The consultation of EU-level social partners involved in the ESSDC, focused on the recommendations and aimed at including them into the works of the Committee; and, simultaneously, the involvement of transport sector-related national social partners in a capacity building session.

TRANSFER will meet the Call's requirements related to:

- involvement of both trade unions and employers' organizations;
- support and commitment from EU-level social partners;
- work on issues, topics and priorities defined within EU-level social dialogue;
- contribution to the works of the Civil Aviation Committee;
- improvement of social partners' capacities to trigger effective social dialogue outcomes in civil aviation.

It is important to highlight that, while in Romania and Italy the experts will be contracted, in the remaining countries (Poland, Bulgaria and Montenegro) the expected workload will be performed by inhouse experts, employed within the relevant organizations involved in the specific country. 		Samples will be formed by at least 40 people (20 from trade unions and 20 from employers' organizations). The activity will foresee the participation of all involved organizations (participants and associated partners, with the exception of CESI and ATCEUC). While some will directly be involved in realizing the survey, other will facilitate the identification of respondents, ensuring the creation of the expected national samples. This will be the case of the Romanian organizations included in the action, which will not directly take part in the realization of the survey, but only facilitate its realization by mobilizing the needed respondents.		
		The questionnaire will be based on the feedback and recommendations emerged from the International Event in Rome, but it will be also tailored on the priorities identified by the European Sectorial Social Dialogue Committee on civil aviation.
